Course Prefix and Number: ART 100

Credits: 3

Course Title: Art Appreciation

Course Description: Introduces art from prehistoric times to the present day. Describes architectural styles, sculpture, photography, printmaking, and painting techniques. Prerequisites: Placement in English 111 or placement in Co-requisites ENG 111 and EDE 11. Lecture 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: This course will satisfy a Humanities/Fine Arts elective, and will serve to inform anyone wanting to know more about Western Art.

Course Prerequisites and Co-requisites:

Prerequisites: Placement in English 111 or placement in Co-requisites ENG 111 and EDE 11.
