Course Title: Interactive Web Design

Course Description: Provides techniques in interactive web design concepts for cross-platform and low-bandwidth through fast and concise open source applications. Emphasizes the importance of usability, accessibility, optimization, and performance. Understand and implement skills to design web sites for wireless devices. JQuery and jQuery Mobile are used to make websites interactive by reacting to visitor actions, use animations and effects, build drop-down navigation menus, pop-ups, and automate slideshows and more to improve the user interface. Prerequisite or Co-requisite: ITD 210 or equivalent. Lecture 4 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: Required in Web Development Career Studies Certificate, which also feeds into the IST AAS - Web Development concentration. It can also be used as an IT elective in any degree concentration
