COURSE TITLE: Virginia and Federal Procedure

PREREQUISITES: LGL 110

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Examines the rules of procedure in the Virginia and federal court systems, including the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Rules of Practice and Procedure in the General District Court, Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court, Circuit Court, Court of Appeals, and Supreme Court of Virginia. Prerequisite LGL 110. Lecture 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: To understand the Virginia Rules of Court in civil proceedings, and the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

Major Topics to be included:

- a. Virginia Rules in:
 - 1. General District Court
 - 2. Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court
 - 3. Circuit Court
 - 4. Medical Malpractice Review Panel

- b. Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
