<p>Submission of official transcripts: high school, GED, or certificate of completion of home schooling, and college (if applicable) to Central Admissions and Records. <u>Transfer credit</u>: Only official transcripts are evaluated for transfer credits. You must submit a transcript evaluation (Form 11-0036 for VCCS Transcripts) to Admissions and Records</p>	
<p>Science Requirements: Evidence of completion with a grade of “C” or higher for high school biology and chemistry within the last 7 years or any transferable college level science course (PHY, CHM, BIO) or TEAS science sub-test score of 75%, or higher; and completion of ENF 2 if required by placement test.</p>	
<p>Math Requirement: Documentation of Virginia Placement Test through level MTE 5 or higher, successful completion of the developmental modules, or meet waiver criteria per College Catalog (see Enrollment Services for these waivers)</p>	
<p>If English is not your first language, the program requires submission of TOEFL scores. See catalog and/or program website for details.</p>	
<p>Financial Aid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Meet regularly with a Financial Aid Specialist in Enrollment Services for planning. ▪ Review the credits required for each semester. Most courses are in a 16 week format. ▪ Only courses listed within the AAS Nursing program are eligible for financial aid. 	
<p>Completion of the following courses: SDV 101, ENG 111, PSY 230, and BIO 141.</p>	
<p>GPA = 2.5 (curricular)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Based on the most recent grades earned for SDV 101, ENG 111, PSY 230, and BIO 141. 	
<p>GPA = 2.0 (cumulative) – Overall Reynolds GPA</p>	
<p>Completion of the Kaplan Nursing Admission Test with the at least the following test scores: Reading = 73% Math score = 75% Science = 55% Writing 52%</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ See www.reynolds.edu/student_services/testing_center/default.aspx for Testing Center details. (days open, hours, location) ▪ The Kaplan Nurse Admission Test may be repeated once. A two-year interval is required once the test has been taken twice. Be prepared for this test. ▪ Applications are ranked based on Kaplan admission scores. <i>Weighted scores for each section are:</i> Reading = 30% Math =30% Science = 30% Writing = 10%. 	
<p>Complete the mandatory Pre-Information Session Assignment prior to attending the session. This is posted on the website also www.reynolds.edu/get_started/programs/snah/announcements.aspx.</p>	
<p>Information Session Requirement: Attend an Information Session within six (6) months of applying to the program. This is mandatory. These sessions are scheduled periodically throughout the semester at Lipman Auditorium on Parham Road Campus. As new dates and times become available, they will be updated on the program website: www.reynolds.edu/get_started/programs/snah/announcements.aspx.</p>	
<p>Once admitted</p> <p><u>Grading</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The Grading Scale within the AAS Nursing program is: A = 92 – 100 B = 84 – 91 C = 80 – 83 ▪ A “C” is required in each Nursing program course in order to progress through the program. ▪ Any course grade of “D” or “F” must be repeated before moving to the next course. ▪ A course can only be repeated once. Two nursing course failures results in removal from the program. <p><u>Program Progression</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Progression to the next semester is based on successful completion of the current semester. Pre- and co-requisite courses must be taken in the sequence identified in the catalog. ▪ BIO 142, BIO 150, ENG 112 and a humanities/fine arts elective (from the approved list for the program) must be completed prior to or within the identified semester with the co-requisite nursing courses. ▪ Please note, if you have completed the general education courses prior to the semester, your financial aid may be impacted based on number of credits enrolled.
