Course Title: Coordinated Internship in Dental Assisting

Course Description: Supervises on-the-job training in selected business, industrial or service firms coordinated by the college. Provides students clinical experience to supplement DNA 113 through hands-on experience in the dental clinic at Reynolds. Students will be assisting various dental practices. Prerequisites or Co-requisites: DNA 100, DNA 103, DNA 108, DNA 109, DNA 110, DNA 113, DNA 120, DNA 114, DNA 119, and DNA 134. Laboratory 8 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: DNA 190 helps to prepare the student for employment by adding to their clinical hours and experience, as well as supplementing other courses.
