



Is your financial aid ready for Fall 2022 and Spring 2023?
Classes begin on August 22nd, so prepare now and stress less!

Where do I start?

- Submit your 22-23 FAFSA at studentaid.gov.
- Check your MyReynolds SIS Student Services Center.
 - Read any Message Center notifications.
- Are items requested on your Student Center To Do List?
 - Click on the To Do List item to find out more information.
 - Those items will need to be completed before your eligibility can be determined.

Where do I find financial aid forms/documents?

- All financial aid forms can be found on the Reynolds [Financial Aid Central](#) web page in the [Forms/Documents](#) section. Be sure to select the appropriate academic year.

How do I submit my forms/documents?

- Use the upload tool by clicking on the To Do List item in your SIS Student Services Center.
- Email to finaid@reynolds.edu. Include your name and student ID number on all documents.
- Fax to (804)371-3739. Include your name and student ID number on all documents.
- Submit in person at the Financial Aid Office during College business hours. No appointment needed.

How can I see my financial aid offer?

- Log into your MyReynolds SIS Student Services Center.
- Go to the Finances Section:
 - Click "**Account Inquiry**" to see charges and pending aid. Click the yellow bar to adjust your aid to your actual enrollment.
 - Click "**View Financial Aid**" and select the aid year to see what types of aid you have been offered.

Other helpful tips:

- Allow up to 10 business days for review for submitted documents.
- Always enroll in all your classes at one time. Late adding and dropping can affect your financial aid offer.
- If available, be sure to complete the Bookstore Authorization To Do List item to use your excess aid in the bookstore.
 - Fall bookstore charging begins on August 8th.
