

Connecting Devices to JSR-Public

For devices belonging to users that do not have VCCS (MyReynolds) credentials, the JSR-Public network can be used to authenticate a device via SMS text message.

Connect a Wireless Device via SMS Text Confirmation

- Connect to the JSR-Public wireless network to associate the wireless client. You may select the checkbox to 'Connect Automatically' to save this network connection for later use.



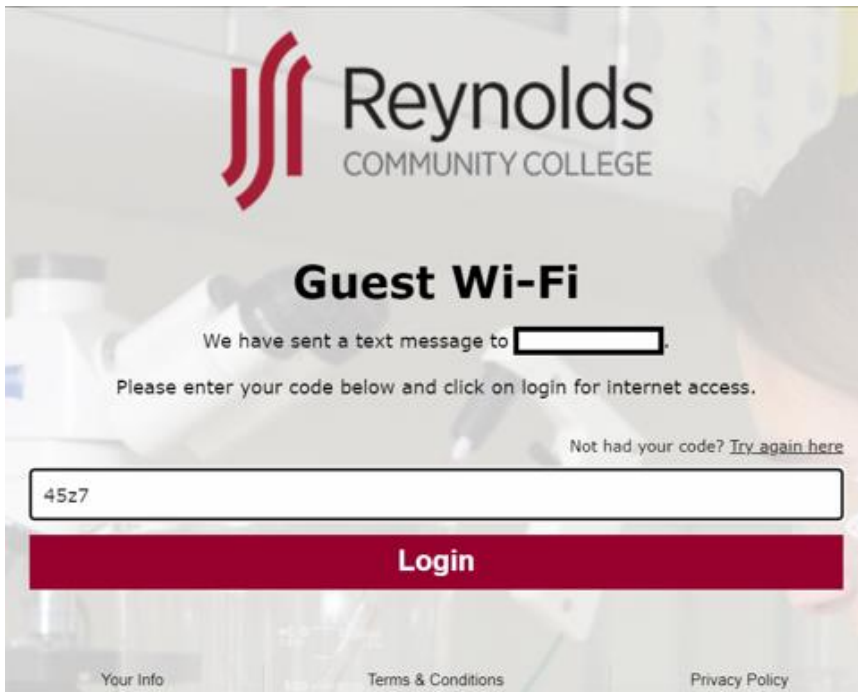
- The Reynolds captive portal will display in a webpage prompting for user credentials to continue. Please enter your mobile phone number and name after accepting the Terms and Conditions to receive a confirmation text code to continue.



- After selecting **Continue** a code will be sent via SMS text message that will need to be entered on the next screen.
